Moved by Schovanec, seconded by Rasmussen, to adopt Resolution 2019-23. Said Resolution approves Payment Application #6 from Sioux City Engineering in the amount of \$136,833.75 for work completed

on the 2018 Street Improvement Project. Roll call vote: Voting Aye: Schovanec and Rasmussen. Nays: Haase. Motion carried.
